He has appeared in TV commercials and independent films; instructed at the Ringling Brothers Barnum and Bailey Clown College in Florida; he has worked as a character consultant for Tri-Star Pictures; and he has been a trainer for 'Circus of the Stars' in Hollywood. Judkins has also taught master classes in character and physical theater at the Julliard School of Drama in New York City. He's a member of the three person 'Maine Hysterical Society'. Another claim to fame is that he once ran the Beach to Beacon 10K Road Race, the entire 6.2 miles while juggling three balls. He finished in under an hour without dropping a ball!**
